AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE 2017-115 REGARDING ABATEMENT **UPON** THE **ACCEPTANCE** AND/OR PROCESSING OF APPLICATIONS FOR COLLOCATION ON EXISTING OR CREATION OF NEW UTILITY POLES IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO SUPPORT SMALL WIRELESS **FACILITIES** OR MICRO WIRELESS **FACILITIES**; REPEALING ALL **ORDINANCES** OR PARTS ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the state legislature passed a bill (HB 687) amending Florida Statutes Section 337.401, regarding the use of right-of-way for utilities, and more specifically creating regulations called the "Advanced Wireless Infrastructure Deployment Act"; and

WHEREAS, this Bill was signed into law by the Governor, and went into effect on July 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, this law provides new requirements for municipalities in regards to collocation on existing or creation of new utility poles in the right-of-way to support small wireless facilities or micro wireless facilities; and

WHEREAS, the law allows for some local government regulation in this area, including some existing regulations and certain objective design standards, among others; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa staff studied the new law and created new regulations allowed under the law, and the abatement is no longer necessary; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public hearing as required by law was held by the City Council of the City of Tampa, at which public hearing all residents and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That the aforementioned recitations are true and correct.
