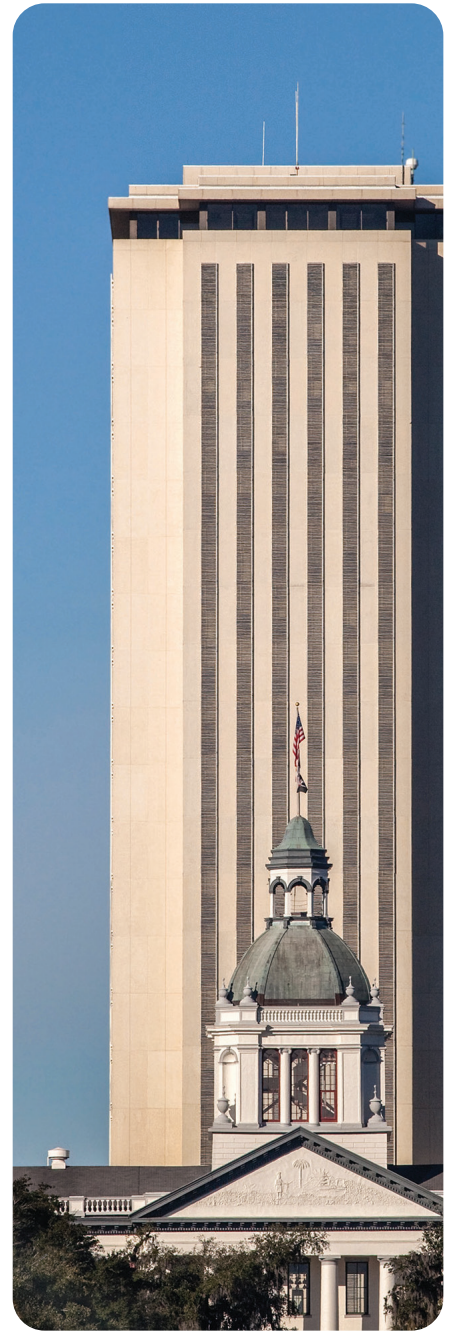
The event begins on **Tuesday, February 11** with a legislative briefing at 10:00 a.m. in Tallahassee's City Hall Chambers, located at 300 S. Adams Street. Following the briefing, pick up your box lunch from 12:00 p.m.- 1:00 p.m. and meet up with your regional group. After lunch, plan to visit the Capitol for scheduled meetings with your legislators. League staff will work with local/regional leagues to coordinate and schedule appointments. **Please indicate your local/regional league on the registration form on page 3.**

All registrants are invited to the FLC Legislative Action Days Reception on **Tuesday, February 11**, at the Doubletree Hotel, located at 101 S. Adams Street, from 5:30 p.m.- 6:30 p.m. Share ideas with your city colleagues and legislators in a relaxed setting.
