This is the first of three committee stops in the House.
- <u>HB 3</u> (Leek) Law Enforcement Officer, Benefits, Recruitment, and Training Support HB 3 passed all of its committees of reference and is now on the February 15 House Special Order Calendar. There is no Senate companion bill.

They are: <u>Senator Dennis Baxley</u>, <u>Senator Ed Hooper</u> and <u>Senator Travis Hutson</u>. Last Friday, SB 974 received an *additional* committee reference – the Rules Committee.
