

## Summary of February 28, 2022, FLC Monday Morning Call-In

### Amber Hughes Update:

- [HJR 1](#) (Tomkow) **Additional Homestead Property Tax Exemption for Specified Critical Public Service Workforce** and [HB 1563](#) (Tomkow) **Implementing Bill to HJR 1 – Oppose** – HJR 1 and HB 1563 will be heard today, February 28, at 10:30 a.m. in the Senate Appropriations Committee. Both bills passed the full House (115-0) on February 24.
- [HB 301](#) (Roach) **Financial Disclosures/Form 6 – Oppose** – HB 301 will be heard today, February 28, at 3:30 p.m. in the House State Affairs Committee. This is the final committee stop in the House. The Senate companion bill, SB 510 (Brodeur), passed the full Senate (30-7) on February 23.

### David Cruz Update:

- Update on Sovereign Immunity:
  - [SB 974](#) (Gruters) – SB 974 passed the Senate Rules Committee on February 23. The bill was significantly amended (tiered approach by population), and the League is now neutral on the Senate bill. SB 974 has one more committee stop in the Senate, the Appropriations Committee. Today is the last scheduled Senate Appropriations Committee meeting, and SB 974 is not on the committee agenda.
  - The House companion bill, [HB 985](#) (Beltran), will be heard today, February 28, at 3:30 p.m. in the House Judiciary Committee. This is the final committee stop in the House. The League remains **opposed to HB 985**.
