- [SB 1876](#) (Albritton) and [HB 421](#) (Tuck, Persons-Mulicka) **Relief from Burdens on Real Property Rights/Bert Harris Act** – **Oppose** – SB 1876 will be heard on Tuesday, April 20 at 8:30 a.m. in the Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate. HB 421 is on the House Special Order Calendar on Tuesday, April 20.
- [HB 403](#) (Giallombardo) **Home-based Businesses** – **Oppose** – HB 403 is on the House Special Order Calendar on Tuesday, April 20. The House bill has the complete preemption language in the bill.
