David Cruz Update:

- [SB 1066](#) (Gruters) – **Impact Fees** – **Oppose** – SB 1066 will be heard today at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops.
- [SB 1766](#) (Lee) – **Bert Harris/Growth Management** – **Oppose** – SB 1766 will be heard today at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the second of three committee stops. SB 1766 was significantly amended at the last committee stop. The League still opposes the bill but this version is better than the House bill. Message to Senator Lee is to not take up the House version.
- [HB 1161](#) (Plakon) – **Local Licensing/Reciprocity** – **Oppose** – HB 1161 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 1:30 p.m. in the House Government Operations & Technology Appropriations Subcommittee. This is the second of three committee stops.
- [CS/SB 410](#) (Perry) – **Growth Management/Comprehensive Plan to Address Private Property Rights** – **Oppose/Unfunded Mandate** – CS/SB 410 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 2:00 p.m. in the Senate Judiciary Committee. This is the second of three committee stops.

- [CS/HB 1371](#) (Fine) – **Traffic & Pedestrian Safety** – **Oppose** – CS/HB 1371 will be heard today at 1:30 p.m. in the House Transportation & Tourism Appropriations Subcommittee. This is the second of three committee stops.
- [SB 1352](#) (Brandes) – **Transportation Companies** – **Oppose** – SB 1352 will be heard today at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Innovation, Industry, and Technology Committee. This is the second of three committee stops. CS/SB 478 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 2:00 p.m. in the Senate Banking and Insurance Committee. This is the second of three committee stops.

- [SB 1512](#) (Diaz) – **Local Government Reporting** – **Oppose** – SB 1512 will be heard today at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops.
- [HB 5007](#) (Appropriations Committee) and [SB 7044](#) (Appropriations Committee) – Both chambers will discuss their budget bills on Wednesday, February 12. The Senate is in session at 10:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. and the House is in session at 1:30 p.m. until completion. Both bills include FRS rates for the next fiscal year.
- [SB 664](#) (Lee) – **E-Verify (Private & Public entities)** – **Watch** – SB 664 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 2:00 p.m. This is the first of three committee stops.

Casey Cook Update:

- **SB 1128** (Diaz) – **Short-Term Rentals** – **Oppose** – SB 1128 will be heard on **Tuesday, February 11 at 10:00 a.m. in the Senate Commerce and Tourism Committee**. The meeting will be held in 110 Senate Office Building (a small meeting room). If you plan to be in Tallahassee for Legislative Action Days and your senator serves on this committee, please plan to attend the meeting. The senators on the committee are: Senators Gruters, Torres, Hutson, Stewart and Wright. If you plan to speak against the bill, please be prepared to tell a story from your city – this hits home with legislators and personalizes the issue. FLC will have appearance forms available at the Legislative Briefing. - **CS/CS/SB 1340** (Gruters) – **Legal Notices** – **Support** – CS/CS/SB 1340 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 2:00 p.m. in the Senate Judiciary Committee. This is the first of three committee stops.
- **SB 630** (Mayfield) – **Regulation of Smoking in Parks** – **Support** – SB 630 will be heard on Wednesday, February 12 at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Rules Committee. This is the final committee stop in the Senate.

Rebecca O’Hara Update:

- **SB 1270** (Lee) – **Fiduciary Duty of Care for Appointed Public Officials and Executive Officers** – **Oppose** – SB 1270 will be heard today at 1:30 p.m. in the Senate Governmental Oversight and Accountability Committee. This is the first of three committee stops.
- **CS/SB 724** (Albritton) – **Local Government Recycling Programs** – **Support** – CS/SB 724 will be heard today at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the second of three committee stops. It is likely the bill will be temporarily postponed today due to no movement on the House companion bill.
- **SB 1378** (Rouson) – **Vessels/Anchoring Near Mangroves** – **Support** – SB 1378 will be heard today at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Environment and Natural Resources Committee. This is the first of three committee stops.
- **CS/SB 996** (Albritton) – **Displacement of Private Waste Companies** – **Oppose** – CS/SB 996 will be heard today at 4:00 p.m. in the Senate Environment and Natural Resources Committee. This is the second of three committee stops.
- **CS/HB 715** (Maggard) – **Reclaimed Water** – **Support & Oppose** – CS/HB 715 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 1:30 p.m. in the House Agriculture & Natural Resources Appropriations Subcommittee. This is the second of three committee stops. **If your city has a wastewater utility, it is recommended that you immediately consult your utility director on this bill to find out if any of the enumerated exceptions apply to you. If they don’t, then you need to determine if the 2026 deadline is going to be feasible from a technical standpoint and a practical standpoint.**
- **CS/HB 1091** (Fine) – **Environmental Enforcement** – **Watch** – CS/HB 1091 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 1:30 p.m. in the House Agriculture & Natural Resources Appropriations Subcommittee. This is the second of three committee stops.
- **HB 1343** (Payne & Ingoglia) – **Water Quality Improvements** – **Watch** – HB 1343 will be heard on Tuesday, February 11 at 4:00 p.m. in the House Appropriations Committee. This is the second of three committee stops.
