- [SB 1592](#) (Burgess) **Broadband Internet Infrastructure – Oppose** – SB 1592 will be heard on Tuesday, March 9 at 9:00 a.m. in the Regulated Industries Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. The House companion bill, HB 1239 (Tomkow), has not yet been heard in a committee.

- [HB 403](#) and [SB 266](#) (Perry) **Home-based Businesses – Oppose** – HB 403 will be heard on Tuesday, March 9 at 3:45 p.m. in the House Commerce Committee. This is the last committee stop in the House. SB 266 will be heard on Wednesday, March 10 at 8:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. - [CS/HB 55](#) (Overdorf) **Building Design – Oppose** – HB 55 will be heard on Tuesday, March 9 at 3:45 p.m. in the House Commerce Committee. This is the final committee stop in the House. The Senate bill, SB 284 (Perry) has not yet been heard in a Senate committee.
- [SB 1382](#) (Perry) **Building Inspections – Oppose** – SB 1382 will be heard on Wednesday, March 10 at 8:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. The House companion, HB 667 (Mooney), passed its first committee of reference last week.
- [SB 1788](#) (Boyd) **Construction Permits – Oppose** – SB 1788 will be heard on Wednesday, March 10 at 8:00 a.m. in the Senate Community Affairs Committee. This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. The House companion, HB 1059 (Robinson), passed its first committee of reference last week.

This is the first of three committee stops in the Senate. HB 663 will also be heard on Tuesday, March 9 at 3:45 p.m. in the House Commerce Committee. This is the last committee stop in the House.
- [HB 883](#) (Overdorf) **Code Enforcement** – **Oppose** – HB 883 will be heard on Tuesday, March 9 at 9:30 a.m. in the House Local Administration & Veterans Affairs Subcommittee. This is the first of three committee stops in the House. The Senate companion, SB 60 (Bradley), passed it first two committees of reference and has one more stop, the Senate Rules Committee.
