

# Cookies with the Mayor/Commissioner/Council Member

#### **OVERVIEW**

Cookies with the Mayor/Commissioner/Council Member (or a like event) is a great way to introduce yourself, as an elected official, to students and provide a lesson on city government.

### YOUR ROLE

Make yourself available to talk with students and answer their questions. During this time, provide an overview of city government and how it affects its youngest residents.

#### **RESOURCES**

• Cookies (or other snack)

#### **PREPARATION**

- Work with your local teacher(s) to determine the best time to visit.
- Account for the number of students in attendance, the age of the students and their prior knowledge of city government.
- Prepare a short overview of how city government works and be prepared to answer questions.
- Bring cookies. Speak with the teacher(s) about the student's dietary needs prior to bringing food into the classroom.

## **PROCEDURE**

- Introduce yourself and allow the students to grab a cookie.
- Begin by asking students if they have any prior knowledge of how city government works.

Be prepared to explain aspects such as:

- The roles of an elected official and appointed positions.
- Your city's organizational structure.
- Budget.
- Types of issues with which the council deals.
- Municipal departments and how they affect citizens' lives.
