FEMA PA Expedited Projects - Hurricane Milton

Expedited Projects were created by FEMA in order to pay-out funds to Subrecipients who need immediate funding. Subrecipients are able to submit high-level estimated costs initially to FEMA and receive up to 50% of the estimated costs upfront. Afterwards, Subrecipients will need to provide all supporting documentation to substantiate final eligible costs and receive remaining funding.

Expedited Project Eligibility

- The Project must be for Emergency Work (Category A – Debris Removal or Category B – Emergency Protective Measures).
- A list of potentially eligible Category B activities can be found on pages 110-111 of <u>PAPPG V4</u>.
- The Project must be a Large Project (greater than \$1,062,900.00).
- The Project must have a designated operational period (FEMA suggests 30, 60, or 90 days). For Hurricane Milton, we recommend <u>90 days</u> to align with the 100% Federal cost share timeframe.
- Work must be ongoing and not entirely completed.

Details for Estimates

- A detailed description of the work and documentation to substantiate that the work is eligible. This includes: o Description of immediate threat;
 - o Detailed description of work activities;
 - o Work locations; and

o Additionally, for debris: estimated quantities by type of debris substantiated with photographs or video, temporary staging, and disposal locations with copies of permits and reduction methods, if available.

- The total estimated cost with documentation to support the basis of the estimate and substantiate that the cost estimate is reasonable. This includes:
 - o Insurance documentation
 - o For Force Account labor or other hourly labor costs such as mutual aid labor:
 - \Box Number of personnel;
 - \Box Average hours per day;
 - \Box Average days per week;
 - \Box Average pay rate;
 - \Box Lodging and per diem rates; and
 - □ Mutual Aid Agreement, Memorandum of Understanding or other written agreement

- For Force Account equipment:
 - \Box Amount of equipment by type;
 - \Box Average hours per day;
 - \Box Average days per week; and
 - \Box Hourly rate
- For rented equipment:
 - □ Rental agreement with pricing
- For contract work:
 - □ Request for proposals, bid documents, contracts;
 - □ If bids have not yet been received, the Applicant may submit a unit price estimate; and
 - \Box Debris monitor information
